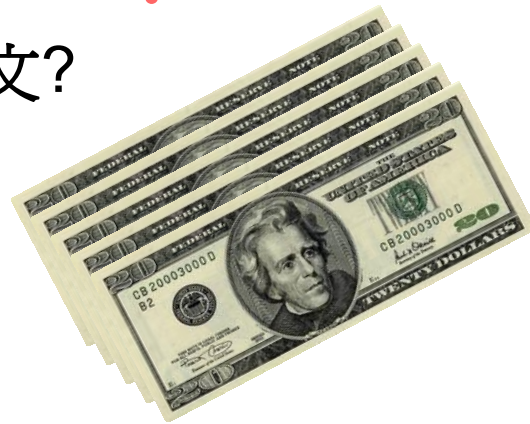

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Poll workers are paid \$8.50/HOUR on Election Day (federal tax exempt) .
- For bilingual poll workers, no language test is required. You will be given a glossary during training.
- Tuesday, April 3, 2012 Election Day working hours are: 6:30AM—8:30PM (set-up with one hour lunch break). Polls open from 7AM—7PM.

HOW TO BECOME AN ELECTION POLL WORKER:

Individuals with Spanish, Vietnamese, Mandarin, or Cantonese language skills are in great demand.

Adults must be a registered voter of Harris County before deadline of March 5, 2012 (To register to vote, visit www.harrisvotes.com)

Students who are at least 16 years old can work with a signed permission slip from parents and school. Please e-mail: lhunter@cco.hctx.net for the form.

Description:

At the request of the voter, bilingual clerks are available to:

1. Read the ballot to the voter
2. Demonstrate how to use the eSlate machine (most common)
3. Provide instructions on how to mark and cast the ballot
4. Other duties: setup and breakdown of election
